Pop Warner Gridders Win Twice To Close Season

The Spang Pop Warner grid squad scored two last minute touchdowns to close out the 1964 season on Sunday and take second place in the loop standings.

Spang ended the season with a four win and two loss record behind Baumholder.

In the Sunday game against Sembach, Spang started a drive with only four minutes left on the clock for a 20 to 7 victory.

Saturday, the Pioneers took the measure of Hahn's Hawks 14-0. Both Spang scores came in the second half of the well played game with Tom Chairsell romping 42 yards for one TD and Ernie Green nine yards for the second tally. Chuck Nicola scored the extra points.

In the finale Sunday, Nicola scored on a nine yard run and also scored the two point conversion to put Spang ahead in the second quarter.

Sembach scored minutes later to make the score at the half

8-7.

Spang scored their second TD with the clock running out as Nicola scored on a 12 yard run. Tom Chairsell intercepted a Sembach pass on the last play of the game and raced into the end zone from 40 yards out to put the game on ice.

In all-league selections announced on Tuesday, Pat Malone was named as the top league quarterback while Bob Beuhler was picked at end, Nicola at halfback, Bob White as defensive linebacker and Al Storer as all league guard.
